Logo

The Maths Week Scotland logo is available in two colours, for use on coloured backgrounds and for white backgrounds.

Colours

You can use any of the colours shown to the right as backgrounds in your communications.

Yellow is used as an accent colour. Use sparingly, and only when on top one of the background colours.

The font for Maths Week Scotland is 'Work Sans'. This is a free-to-use Google Font available to <u>download here</u>. Use the 'Regular' or 'Bold' weights to create hierarchy.

If you cannot install new fonts on your machine use Verdana.

Photography

To echo the energy of the logo, photography appears within a dynamic bolt shape. Use the supplied templates to achieve this effect.

When choosing and positioning photography ensure the main subject of the image is visible within the shape.

Using our brand


- To ensure legibility don't use the yellow logo on a white background. Use the black version instead.
- Don't use the black logo on coloured backgrounds.
- Do not try to recreate the isometric grid. Use the supplied templates.
- Do not change the logo or wording in any way, use the supplied artwork

To ensure the correct brand hierarchy, use the rule on the right as a rough size guide when placing your logo.
